Most of 232-HELP, Inc.'s 2-1-1 program is funded through 232-HELP's fundraising efforts; additional partial funding is through Lafayette Consolidated Government and some through United Way Acadiana.

The plus sign indicates an addition to the subtotal of met needs while the number is the number of needs added to the subtotal of each category whose subcategory was not listed. This reflects the total amount of needs 232-HELP was able to meet during the quarter, including those who may not be relevant to the client.
